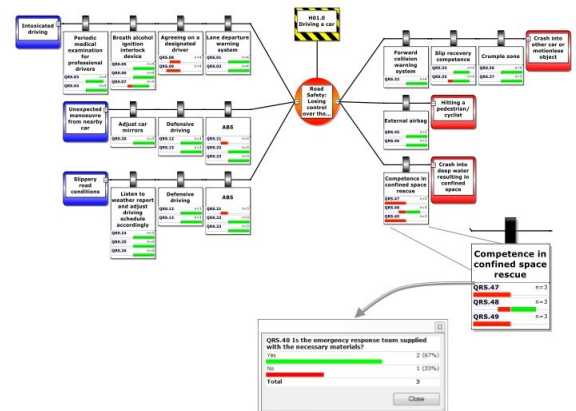

Who is it for?

This course is for participants that are familiar with BowTie and want to build upon it as a strategy for achieving a risk based auditing objective.

Attendees should already have completed the Across Safety 2 day BowTieXP course or similar, or have a good working knowledge of BowTieXP.

What does the course cover?

This course takes participants through the thinking behind how we create effective audits to provide the Safety Performance Indicators (SPIs) we need to drive informed management decisions.

The course also shows participants how to use the AuditXP software via hands on exercises which equip them with the skills to start using AuditXP right away.

Key skills gained during the course:

- How to identify SPIs
- How to draft effective audit questions
- How to create a barrier based audit
- How to use Audits software to create audits
- How to use Audits to aggregate audit results and display them on BowTie models
